

Mae amgáu tomenni awyr agored a gwahardd casglu gwastraff yn ddulliau allweddol o foderneiddio dinasoedd ledled y byd. Mae *The Waste Commons* yn archwilio'r trawsnewidiadau dramatig sy'n gysylltiedig â'r gwaith sydd ar ddod i uwchraddio tomen wastraff y ddinas yn Dakar, Senegal, a'r bywydau sy'n hongian yn y fantol. Mae'n dilyn Zidane carismatig, Adja arloesol, a'u cymuned o gasglwyr gwastraff, wrth iddyn nhw frwydro i amddiffyn eu bydoedd sydd wedi'u llunio'n grefftus a'u hawliau i'r gwastraff.

Enclosing open-air dumps and outlawing waste picking are key approaches to modernizing cities around the world. *The Waste Commons* explores the dramatic transformations involved in the impending upgrade of the city waste dump in Dakar, Senegal, and the lives that hang in the balance. It follows charismatic Zidane, trailblazing Adja, and their waste picker community, as they battle to defend their carefully crafted worlds and rights to waste.

Ynghanol tirweddau gwylt Laos, mae bom yn gorfodi Satu, plentyn a llafurwr gwydn, i ffoi o'i bentref. Gyda Bo, ffotonewyddiadurwr tosturiol, yn gwmni iddo, mae'n teithio tua'r gogledd i ddod o hyd i'w fam goll. Wedi'i saethu ar ffilm oleoul 16mm yn ystod y pandemig, mae'r ffilm deithio dwymgalon hon yn cyfuno goroesi a gobaith, gan ddathlu talent leol a harddwch bywiog De-ddwyrain Asia. Mae'r ffilm *Satu* yn cyfleo ysbryd dyfalbarhad yn wyneb rhwystrau llethol, gan adlewyrchu heriau a hefyd gwobrau ei thaith gynhyrchu ryfedol. Ffilm a 'Made in Wales' gan Joshua Trigg.

Amid the untamed landscapes of Laos, a bomb forces Satu, a resilient child laborer, to flee his village. Joined by Bo, a compassionate photojournalist, he journeys north to find his long-lost mother. Shot on luminous 16mm film during the pandemic, this heartfelt road movie blends survival and hope, celebrating local talent and the vibrant beauty of Southeast Asia. *Satu* captures the spirit of perseverance against overwhelming odds, reflecting both the challenges and rewards of its remarkable production journey. 

A hithau'n seiliedig ar eiriau pwerus y siaman a'r arweinydd Yanomami Davi Kopenawa, mae 'The Falling Sky' yn portreadu cymuned frodorol Watoriki wrth iddi gymryd rhan mewn defod angladd hollbwysig o'r enw Reahu - ymdrech ar y cyd i ddal yr awyr i fyny. Saif y ffilm fel beirniadaeth siamanaidd ffyrnig ar gloddio aur anghyfreithlon, y cymysgedd marwol o epidemigau a gyflwynwyd gan bobl o'r tu allan mae'r Yanomami yn galw'n "xawara", a'r rheiny mae'r Davi'n galw y "bobl nwyddau." Gan arddangos harddwch cosmoleg Yanomami a'i hysbrydion xapiri tra hefyd yn tynnu sylw at bwysigrwydd daearwleidyddol y bobl hyn, mae The Falling Sky yn ein gwahodd i freuddwydio'n eang.

Based on the powerful words of shaman and Yanomami leader Davi Kopenawa, *The Falling Sky* portrays the Indigenous community of Watoriki as it engages in a vital funeral rite known as a Reahu - a collective effort to hold up the sky. The film stands as a trenchant shamanic critique of illegal gold mining, the deadly mix of epidemics brought by outsiders the Yanomami call "xawara", and those Davi calls the "merchandise people." Showcasing the beauty of Yanomami cosmology and its xapiri spirits while also highlighting this people's geopolitical importance, *The Falling Sky* invites us to dream far.

Mae dwy chwaer, Mariam a Noura, yn darganfod bod deddfau etifeddiaeth - a'u brawd sydd wedi ymddieithrio - yn eu rhwystro rhag hawlio ffortiwn eu diweddar dad. Gyda ffaethineb a phenderfyniad, maen nhw'n rhoi cynllun beiddgar ar waith i gymryd yr hyn sy'n eiddo iddyn nhw, gan lywio anhrefn teuluol, disgwyliadau cymdeithasol, a'u personoliaethau eu hunain sy'n gwrthdaro. Yn *Thank You For Banking With Us*, mae'r cyfarwyddwr Laila Abbas yn llunio archwiliad craff ac ingol o ryw, traddodiad, a chwaeroliaeth ym Mhalesteina fodern. Gyda hiwmor brathog ac eliadau twymgalon, mae'r ffilm yn awdl fywiog i wytnwch a'r rhwymau di-dor rhwng menywod sy'n herio system sy'n gweithredu yn eu herbyn.

Two sisters, Mariam and Noura, discover that inheritance laws—and their estranged brother—stand in the way of claiming their late father's fortune. Armed with wit and determination, they embark on a bold scheme to take what's theirs, navigating family chaos, societal expectations, and their own clashing personalities. In *Thank You For Banking With Us*, director Laila Abbas crafts a sharp and poignant exploration of gender, tradition, and sisterhood in modern Palestine. With biting humour and heartfelt moments, the film is a vibrant ode to resilience and the unbreakable bonds between women defying a system stacked against them.

Mewn tref wedi'i hamgylchynu gan gaeau câns siwgr, mae merch ifanc o dras Gweriniaeth Dominica a Haiti yn wynebu bei chiogrwydd digroeso a dyfodol ansicr. Mae sarff, sy'n ymgorffori dirgelion hynafol, yn ymddangos i'w harwain trwy gywilydd, goroesiad a thrawsnewid. Gan gyfuno delweddu trawiadol â dyfnader ysbrydol, mae'r ffilm nodwedd gyntaf hon gan y gwneuthurwr ffilmiau Affro-Caribiidd Johanné Gómez Terrero yn digwydd rhwng y diriaethol a'r aneglur, lle mae traddodiad, gwytnwch, a grym yr anweledig yn llunio ei thaith tuag at hunanddarganfyddiad.

In a town surrounded by sugarcane fields, a young Dominican-Haitian girl faces an unwanted pregnancy and an uncertain future. A serpent, embodying ancestral mysteries, appears to guide her through shame, survival, and transformation. Blending striking imagery with spiritual depth, this debut feature by Afro-Caribbean filmmaker Johanné Gómez Terrero unfolds between the tangible and the obscured, where tradition, resilience, and the power of the unseen shape her journey into self-discovery.



Yn rhanbarth Laikipia yn Kenya, mae bywydau bugeiliaid a thirfeddianwyr yn gwrthdaro mewn brwydr a yrrir gan newid hinsawdd, hanes trefedigaethol, a thensiynau etholiadol. Mae'r ffilm hon yn treiddio i frwydrau Simeon, bugail o Samburu sy'n ymladd i amddiffyn ei wartheg a'i ddiwylliant rhag y ffensys trydan sy'n agosáu, a Maria, disgynydd gwladychwyr o Brydain, sy'n ystyried ei thir yn etifeddiaeth i'w gwarchod. Archwilar eu bydoedd gwrthwynebol – un yn canolbwytio ar gysylltiadau hynafol â'r pridd, a'r llall ar berchenogaeth tir modern – gydag ymdeimlad dwfn o empathi, gan gynnig perspectif cynnil ar y gwrthdaro cymhleth sy'n llunio dyfodol y rhanbarth hwn.

In Kenya's Laikipia region, the lives of herders and landowners collide in a battle driven by climate change, colonial history, and electoral tensions. This film dives into the struggles of Simeon, a Samburu herder fighting to protect his cattle and culture from encroaching electric fences, and Maria, a descendant of British colonists, who views her land as a legacy to preserve. Their opposing worlds – one focused on ancestral ties to the soil, the other on modern landownership – are explored with a deep sense of empathy, offering a nuanced perspective on the complex conflicts shaping the future of this region.



Yn ei dilyniant teimladwy i *Honeyland*, mae'r cyfarwyddwr o Facedonia, Tamara Kotevska, yn mynd â chynulleidfa oedd ar daith afaelgar, o Syria i Fôr Udd. Mae'r ffilm yn dilyn dwy ferch ddewr naw oed sy'n ffoaduriaid – Asil, plentyn amddifad yn Nhwrci heb bapurau swyddogol, ac Amal, pyped enfawr y mae ei phresenoldeb aruthrol yn caniatáu iddi deithio ar draws ffiniau. Wrth i gamau cawraidd Amal ei thywys drwy dirweddau a phentrefi, mae hi'n lledaenu llawenydd, yn cwrdd â chyffoaduriaid, a hyd yn oed yn dod ar draws y Pab. Trwy daith Amal, mae *The Walk* yn archwilio gobaith a gwytnwch anorhfygol plant sy'n ceisio lloches mewn byd cythryblus.

In her poignant follow-up to *Honeyland*, Macedonian director Tamara Kotevska takes audiences on a gripping journey from Syria to the English Channel. The film follows two brave nine-year-old refugee girls—Asil, an orphan stuck in Turkey without papers, and Amal, a giant puppet whose towering presence allows her to travel across borders. As Amal's giant steps take her through landscapes and villages, she spreads joy, meets fellow refugees, and even encounters the Pope. Through Amal's journey, *The Walk* explores the indomitable hope and resilience of children seeking refuge in a tumultuous world.



Mae *Memories of Underdevelopment* yn garreg filltir i sinema fyd-eang ac yn un o'r ffilmiau mwyaf dylanwadol i ddod o America Ladin. Wedi'i chyfarwyddo gan Tomás Gutiérrez Alea ac yn seiliedig ar nofel Edmundo Desnoes, mae'n dilyn Sergio, awdur dadrithiedig sy'n aros yng Nghiwb a'r ôl y chwyldro tra bod ei gyfoedion bourgeois yn ffoi. Wrth iddo fyfyrto ar gynnwrf gwleidyddol, hunaniaeth genedlaethol, a pherthnasoeedd aflwyddiannus, mae'r ffilm yn cyfuno storïa tameidiog, darnau ffilm dogfennol, a ffotograffau llonydd i greu taith-ddwys arddulliadol. Yn ffaeth a phryfoclyd, mae'n parhau i fod yn enghraift ddisglair o arbrofi sinematig Ciwba y 1960au.

Memories of Underdevelopment is a landmark of global cinema and one of the most influential films to emerge from Latin America. Directed by Tomás Gutiérrez Alea and based on Edmundo Desnoes' novel, it follows Sergio, a disillusioned writer who remains in post-revolution Cuba while his bourgeois peers flee. As he reflects on political upheaval, national identity, and failed relationships, the film combines fragmented storytelling, documentary footage, and still photographs to craft a stylistic tour-de-force. Witty and provocative, it remains a shining example of 1960s Cuban cinematic experimentation.


